CHESHIRE, OHIO

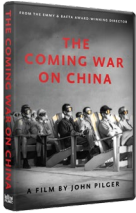

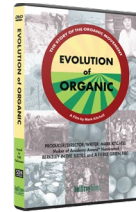

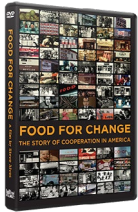
